Try to create word searches and crosswords for other family members to solve. Remember to check the definitions of any words you are unsure of and challenge yourself to use these in any writing you do.</p>
<p><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>Please make use of Times table Rockstars and MyMaths.</p> <p>Work through the CGP books and activities in your pack.</p>	<p><b><u>Art &amp; DT</u></b></p> <p>Use recyclable junk and other objects you can find to make a replica of either HMS Victory or the Mary Rose.</p> <p>Look at Holbein's famous portraits and try to draw a family member in the same style. You may want to use crayons. Felt tips or paints to complete it.</p>	<p><b><u>Topic</u></b></p> <p>With our topic being 'Rule Britannia' try to spend some time looking at how Britain came to control the seas - explore famous battles and recount what happened. Who was involved and the reasons for the battles also explore piracy and famous pirates, why did they become famous, where did they hide their treasures? Records your findings as biographies or information sheets.</p> <p>Create leaflets for 'Tudor Exploration Holidays'</p> <p>How could you encourage Tudor people to set sail and embark on an adventure of discovery?</p>	<p><b><u>PE</u></b></p> <p>Where possible please try to spend some time in your gardens playing, running, kicking and throwing balls.</p> <p>If sensible try to take a short walk in a quiet area for about 30mins every other day.</p> <p>All National Trust areas have now waved their entrance fees and car parking charges so why not go for a scenic walk where safe to do so.</p> <p>Complete some of the 5 Minute Move and Active 8 workouts with Joe Wicks 'The Body Coach' on Youtube.
