

# Year 1 Home Learning

## Literacy/Writing.

Diary writing – make it fun. Encourage your child to write a few sentences about something they have done that day. Remind them about using: Capital letters, finger spaces, full stops and using their phonics to help with spelling. They could always draw a picture to match their busy day!

## Maths

The children all have a log on for Numbot and can be accessed on most devices. The children use this at school so should be able to navigate their way through the different levels. The more levels they complete the more parts they can get to add to their robots. Number recognition within the environment – counting and recognising numbers to 100. Rote counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.

## ICT

If you have access to a computer and/or the internet continue to play Numbots.

Research about the Victorians.

Use recyclable junk and other objects you can find to make a replica of either a Victorian Building. Think back to our trip and the buildings we visited: The Sweet shop, The Chapel, The Hardware Shop and The Chemist.

## Topic:

Our topic this term has been 'The Victorians'. The children could research a range of areas eg. The life of Queen Victoria, Growing up as a child in the Victorian era or comparing the difference between houses then and now. They could produce a simple fact file using the information they have researched via the internet or books.

## Get Creative

Why not spend some time decorating hard boiled eggs for Easter, making Easter cookies or an Easter bonnet. Take photos of your creations and bring them to school when we return.

## Daily Reading

Please read with you child as often as possible, also encourage your child to read by themselves or with a sibling. Whenever you read with your child ask them questions about the story: What do you think will happen next? Why do you think .... is sad? Remind the children about Inference Iggy and Predicting Pip.

Work through the CGP books provided –Year 1 Reading Comprehension. If they are finding the text difficult then help them to read the text but allow the children to answer independently.

## Phonics

Can the children use their phonic knowledge to spot any digraphs or trigraphs? Encourage your child to segment and blend the sounds together to read the alien and real words. I have included a past test paper, the format of which the children are used to using. The children will have a test in June so the more practice the better!

## Spelling

Provide opportunities for your child to read and practice spelling the Common Exception Words that are included in the pack.

## PE

Where possible please try to spend some time in your gardens playing, running, kicking and throwing balls.
